The Coober Pedy region is mostly a treeless desert. Very little plant life exists due to the region's low rainfall and strong heat, so most of the residents live underground to escape the heat. They call their underground homes "dugouts". These dugouts remain at a stable temperature, while normal buildings on the ground need air conditioning.

The average maximum temperature is 30-32°C, but it can get quite warm in the winter. There are a number of underground hotels and tourist shops in the town. The town has become a popular tourist attraction.
