Company research is a critical part of interview preparation.

Practice makes perfect. Take the time to practice answering interview questions you will probably be asked. **This** will also help calm your nerves because you won't be scrambling for an answer while in the interview hot seat. Make a list of questions to ask, too. Almost all interviewers will ask if you have questions. This is a great opportunity for you to show your keenness, enthusiasm, and knowledge.

The interview is your chance to show that you are the best person for the job. Your application or résumé has already exhibited that you are qualified. Now it is up to you to show how your skills and experience match this position and this company. Have an interview outfit ready to wear at all times, so you don't have to think about what you're going to wear while you're scrambling to get ready for a job interview.

Proper interview etiquette is important. Remember to greet the receptionist, your interviewer, and everyone else you meet politely, pleasantly, and enthusiastically. During a job interview, listening is just as important as answering questions. If you're not paying attention, you're not going to be able to give a good response.
